The exterior of homes must be maintained in clean condition. Inspect your home (and mailbox) for cleaning in order to comply with HOA covenants.

All resident vehicles shall be parked in garages or driveways. Limited short term street parking for a MAX of 6 hours is permissible, but no overnight street parking is allowed!!!!

Boats, trailers, campers and similar rec vehicles and equipment should not be stored on any lot except within your garage.

ANY covenant violation is subject to fine.
